BRITISH NUCLEAR TEST PROGRAMME

Preparations for the next British underground nuclear test at the American Nevada Test Site, which you approved as part of the 1980/81 programme in early 1980, are now well advanced to meet a revised planned firing date of about 8 April 1982.

- 2. The publicity arrangements will be as for all our previous tests. These are that there should be no prior announcement of our intentions but that, immediately after the test, a Press statement will be issued simultaneously in London and the United States. As on past occasions, you may wish to give Cabinet some advance warning.
- 3. I am copying this minute to the Home Secretary, the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary, the Chancellor of the Exchequer and to Sir Robert Armstrong.
