## CIPHER TELEGRAM

Today for his request I accepted the GDR's ambassador in Prague. During our discussion, returning to our change of opinions conducted on the $6^{\text {th }}$ February about the improtance of the English prime minister's visit to Budapest, he stated that on the GDR's side they accepted in a puzzled way the articles published in the Slovakian Právda and Rudé Právo about the evaluation of the visit. They do not agree with the two articles' conclusions, and to express this they published their opinion in the Neues Deutschland's issue of $10^{\text {th }}$ February. Referring to the opinion of the hightest party and state leaders, on behalf of the GDR they retain necessary the maintenance of dialogue in the interest to reduce [the tension of] international situation and they disapprove that on Czechoslovakian part referring to the Moscow consultation of brother parties' secretaries of central committees they condemn [original Hungarian "grade as condemning"] the steps of single brother countries. $=$
