The miners' leader has a wonderful chart for an artist. Fantasy is a realm he inhabits with ease. Saturn (reality, common sense) sits at 180 degrees to Neptune (unreality, artistic creativity, escapism) in his chart with Mercury (communication, mind) at 90 degrees to both. So he see-saws between Saturn and Neptune, and has problems distinguishing between what is real and what is not.

The text book advice is: "Don't become so committed to a position that you can't let go of it without damaging your belief in yourself. This period may take away elements of your life that you have identified with, to show you your existence doesn't depend on them."

My additional advice would be: "Take it easy; find peace and quiet; and watch your health."
