It is obviously a good idea to invite Gorbachev and Aliev: there is a chance they will come and it would do them good. But no-one seriously expects Chernenko to come for the time being: so it just loks like a routine gesture, made at a moment when such gestures might seem rather offensive against the background of Sakharov and Shcharansky, etc. I have discussed with Stephen, who shares this view.
